Dear Judge Shipp:

I am a member of the class action lawsuit in the above captioned matter (New Jersey Tax Lien Settlement). I write to you out of sincere concern with regards to the activity and conduct of the plaintiff's attorneys.

The case, as the class was told by the plaintiff's attorneys, was to conclude and settlement checks would be issued upon the completion of the case that was brought forth by Arlene M. Davies. On or about September 6, 2018, the case involving Miss Davies concluded and the class was advised by the plaintiff's attorneys that checks would be issued prior to the end of December 2018, unfortunately that did not occur.

Thereafter, the class was advised by the plaintiff's attorneys that they were finalizing the logistics of the settlement checks and a motion had to be submitted to the courts in order for it to be approved. Without receiving any answer with respect to the status of the motion that was alleged to have been submitted to the

court's to obtain approval of the disbursement of the settlement checks to the class members, the plaintiff's attorneys then stated they had to reconfigure the calculations and checks would be issued thereafter.

Without giving a definitive date on the disbursement of the settlements checks and no transparency, the plaintiff attorneys then stated that settlement checks would be issued out on March 24, 2018, unfortunately that has not occurred. It has been almost six months since the Arlene M. Davies case had concluded and it appears that the plaintiff attorneys are not providing any transparency to the class members. The plaintiff attorneys have millions of dollars of the class member's settlement proceeds and their actions or inaction are causing the class member's a grave concern and suspicion.

It appears that the plaintiff attorneys have no motivation or desire to issue the settlement checks to the class members as required, unless you Order the plaintiff attorneys before you (at their expense) under oath and explain their actions with respect to the issues that I bring forth to you today.

In addition, *I am requesting that you consider imposing daily sanctions against them for their intentional repeated delays and lack of transparency to the class members in order to get them to act in good faith and have them explain how they determined the amount each class members are to receive. OTHERWISE, THEY CAN ISSUE WHATEVER AMOUNT THEY DESIRE TO THE CLASS MEMBERS AND WE WOULD HAVE NO-RECOURSE TO HOLD THEM ACCOUNTABLE.*

Judge Shipp, we are requesting your immediate assistance, otherwise, we as a class may not receive our proper share of the proceeds of the settlement. Their actions makes no sense!
